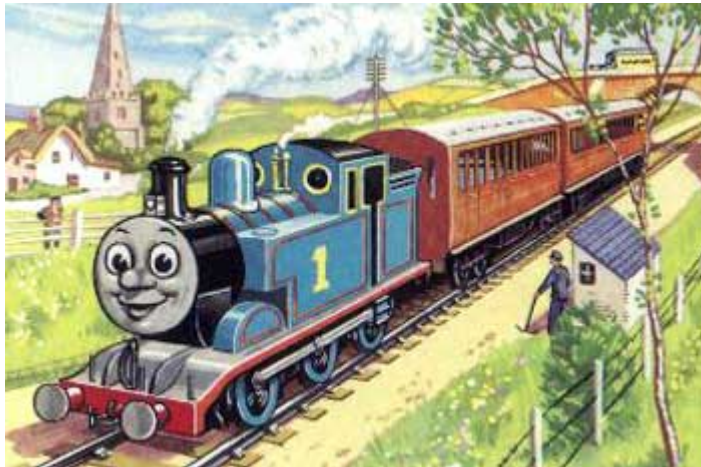
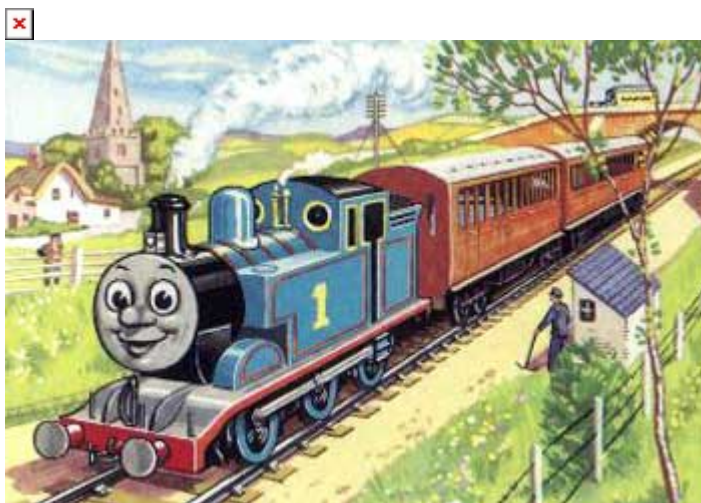


CROSS-ATLANTIC RURAL NOSTALGIAS?
