Our exploration of the world of engaging things continues.

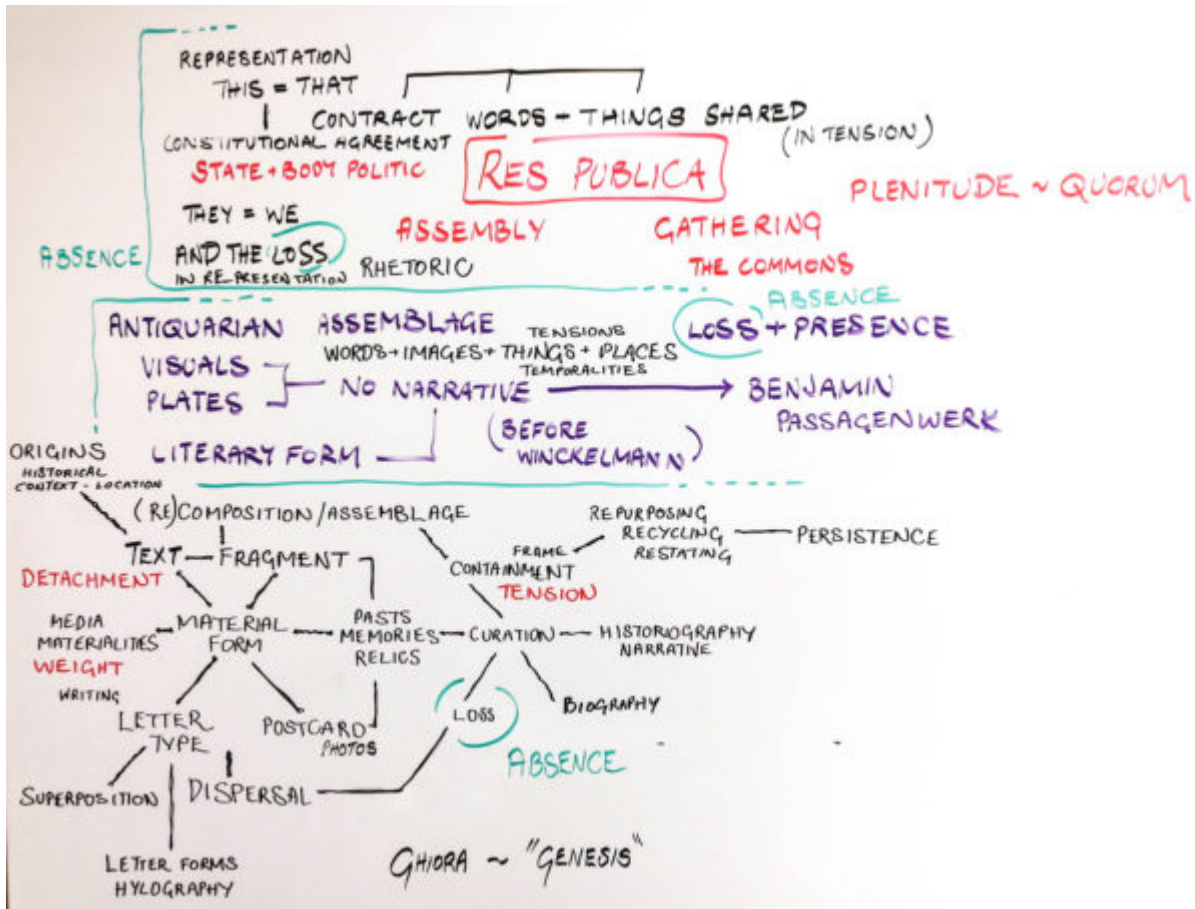
This week the theme was
