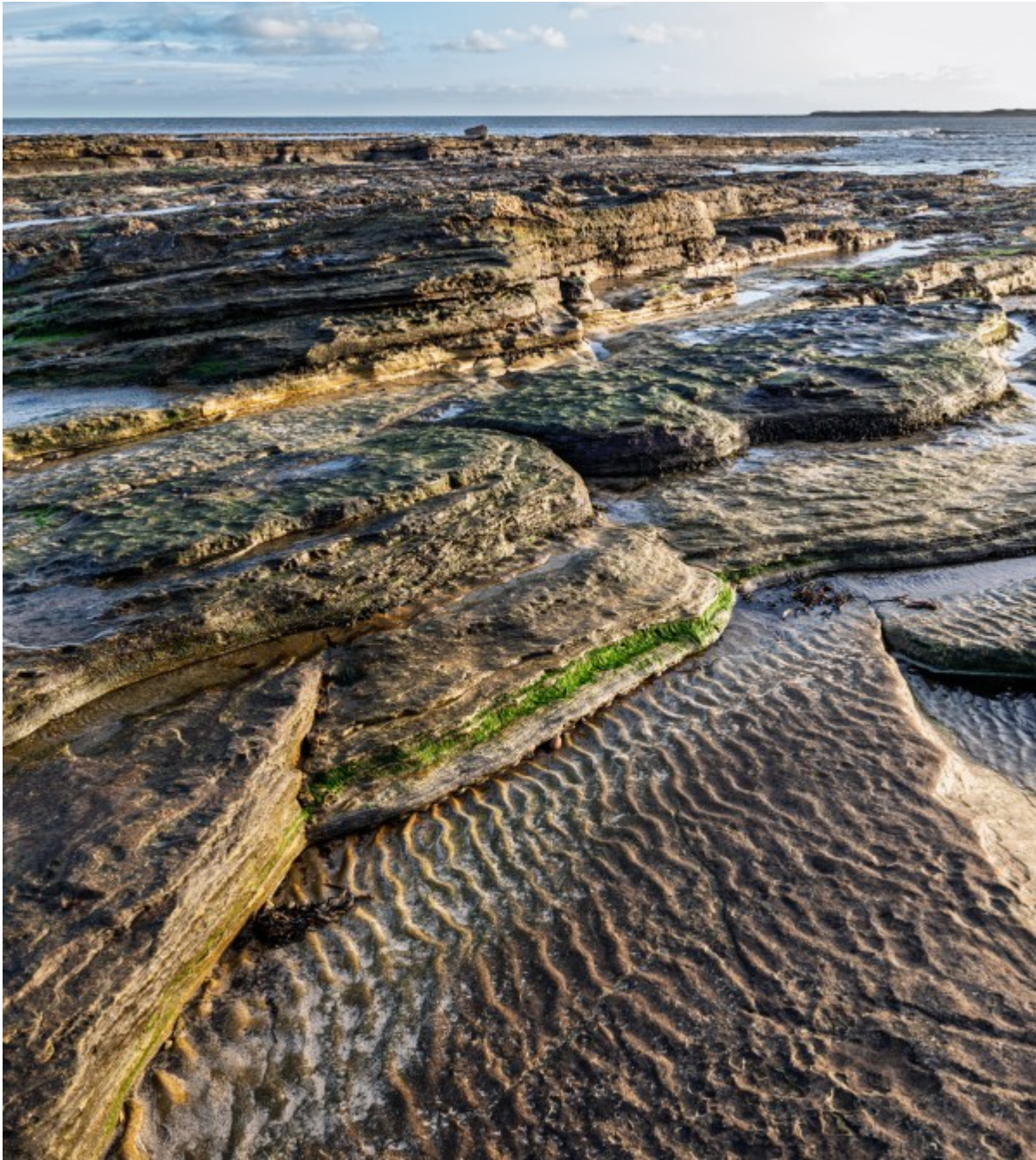


RIPPLES IN DEEP TIME

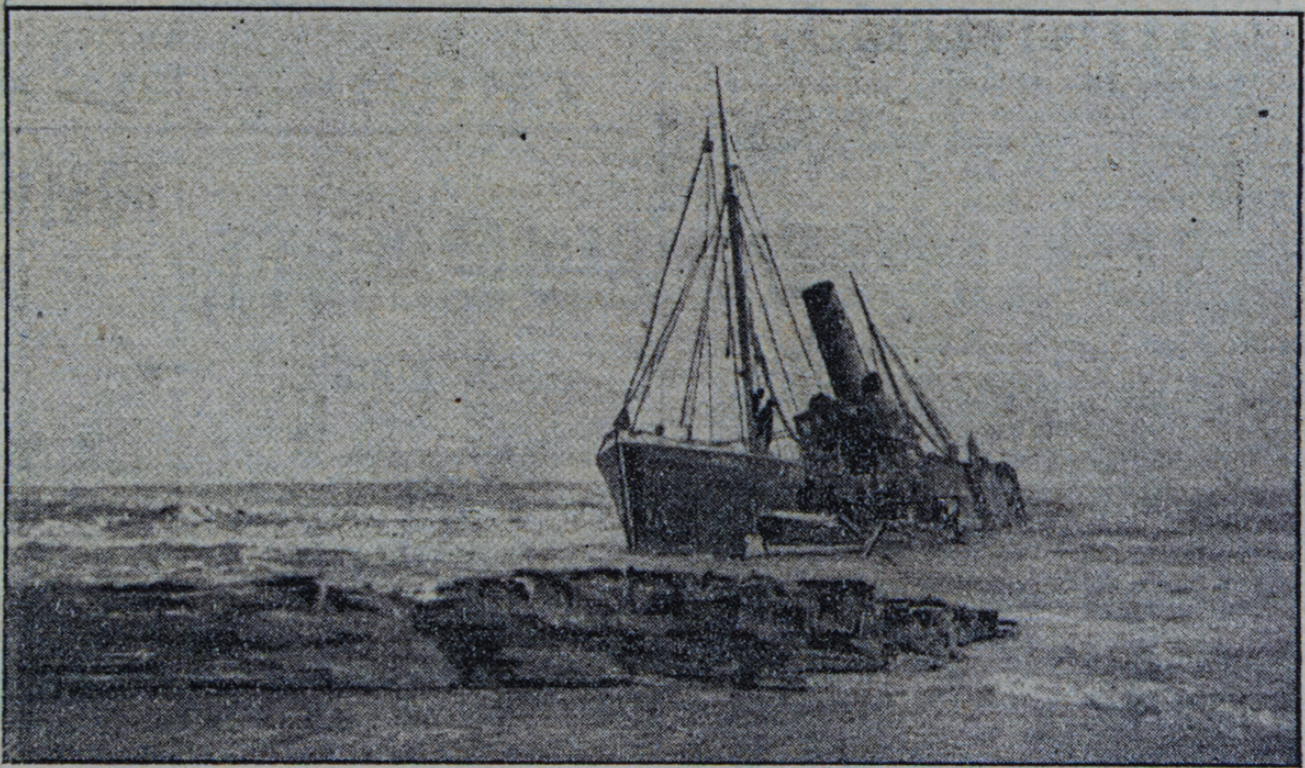
